It is brought to the notice of the undersigned that Language Pandits Grade-II who were upgraded into Grade-I Language Pandit Scale as per the G.O.Ms.No. 330, Education, dated 10-8-1983 are being shown as seniors to the School Assistants who have been working as School Assistants from 01-01-1976.

In continuation of this office proceedings read above, all the under mentioned officers are informed that the seniority shall be counted from the date of first appointment as per the Rule 33 of Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996. A number of School Assistants were appointed as School Assistants on 01-01-1976 (Some were appointed in upgraded posts, some were given upgraded scale, some were appointed under half-a-million job scheme). Government have issued guidelines to fix the seniority among the School Assistants working as School Assistants from 01-01-1976 vide reference read above.

The under mentioned officers are hereby informed that the guidelines issued in the reference read above, should be applied in case of the teachers working as School Assistants from 01-01-1976 only (in tip-graded posts, taking the upgraded scale, appointed from half-a-million job scheme). The teachers who were appointed taking the scale as Language Pandits Grade-I after 01-01-1976 shall not be given seniority over the teachers working as School Assistants from 01-01-1976.
