ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above orders were issued provincialising the services of all Panchayat Raj Employees in the state including those of teachers working in the schools under the control of the Panchayat Samithis and Zilla Parishads . It was also ordered there in to bring out necessary amendments to service rules. Accordingly amendment for special rules for Andhra Pradesh Educational Subordinate Services were issued under the proviso to Article 309 of the constitutions of India as Part – II of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Subordinate Service rules in the G.O. second read above with retrospective effect from 20-3-1981 i.e., from the date of provincialisation of the services of the teachers.

Subsequently, the representatives of the teachers Organizations requested to bring amendments to the relevant rules so that the services of the Government Teachers and Panchayat Raj Teachers are regulated and promotions effected in a single unit in a smooth way .Subsequently a sub-committee was constituted in the G.O. 3rd read above to consider the issues in detail and to make recommendations . The sub –committee made its recommendations . These recommendations were discussed by the Principal Secretary to Government ,Educations Department ;Secretary, Panchayat Raj Department and Secretary (service) General Administration Department with the representatives of the FAPTO and State Teachers Union in a meeting called for the purpose. After due

consideration of the views expressed in the meeting ,Government issue the following orders .

- I. An Education Board shall be set up for each District with the District Collector as its Chairman. The Board will be Assisted by an Executive Officer of the rank of the Joint Director from the Department of the School Education. The Board will Consists of non-officials also. The Board shall undertake to recruit both teaching and non-teaching personel at District level. Executive Officer will be the incharge of the administration, Inspection and other matters related to the entire district.
- II. The day – to – day management of the Educational Institutions shall continue to be under the Zilla Parishads.
- III. Three of four single teacher schools shall be brought under the administrative control of one Headmaster of a nearby Upper Primary School.
- IV. The posts under Zilla Parishad shall be Zonalised. However, posts up to the level of school Assistants shall continue as district level posts for which the district will be the unit of appointment. For the posts of Headmasters Zone will be the Unit:
- V. In consideration of the fact that the District Education Boards would be Headed by the District Collectors, there shall be an Officer of the rank of Commissioner as Head of the school Education Directorate.
- VI. Under the Existing set – up, Regional Joint Director is the appointing Authority for certain posts. consequent to the constitution of the District Education Boards ,there shall be another intermediatry agency between the Executive Officer of the District Education Board and the Head of the Department of School Education in place of the Existing Regional Joint Director for more than one District.

4.The Director of School Education is requested to take suitable action for implementing the above orders of Government and submit necessary proposals for approval of Government whenever necessary.

5.Orders on the other recommendations of the Sub-Committee are being issued separately.
