ORDER:

The One Man Services Rules Commission while observing that there should be more direct recruits since their overall intake has been very low, has recommended that the ideal ratio could be 50:50, but due to special circumstances it would be reasonable to earmark at least 30% of posts for direct recruitment.

2. The Government, keeping in view the percentages already prescribed for different posts for which direct recruitment has been provided in the State and Subordinate Services, have after examination accepted the recommendation. Accordingly, the Government direct that in respect of the posts in the State and Subordinate Services where the percentage earmarked for direct recruitment falls short of 30%, it be increased at least to 30% as recommended by the One Man Services Rules Commission.

3. All Departments of the Secretariat are requested to amend the special rules/Ad-hoc rules with which they are concerned accordingly in consultation with the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission.

PROMOTION OF ABSENTEE MEMBERS OF FORFEITURE OF RIGHTIN THE  
PROMOTED POST ADHOC RULE STATE AND SUBDINATE SERVICE -RE-  
ISSUED

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh, in super session of the Adhoc Rule issued in G.O.Ms.No.356, General Administration Department, dated the 1st July, 1983 hereby makes the following adhoc rule namely: -

**ADHOC RULE**

Notwithstanding anything in the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Services Rules or the Special Rules or the Adhoc Rules for the time being applicable to the post concerned, if a Government servant, while working in the Department or on deputation or otherwise, holding a post outside the Office other than his own, when appointed to a post either on promotion to any higher category, or to a post on recruitment by transfer in his parent Department, he shall be allowed a joining time of thirty days from the date of receipt by him of the order of his promotion or recruitment by transfer, where any Government Servant fails to join, or evades joining, by applying for leave or otherwise the new post to which he is so appointed, within the said time of thirty days, he shall forfeit all his rights, both present and future, for such higher post.
