ORDER :

1. In the G.O.s 1st, 2nd & 3rd above, orders have been issued drawal of full pay to the extent of six months in lieu of months half-pay leave at credit, by all regular Government servants suffering from Leprosy/Tuberculosis/Cancer/Mental illness and Heart deceases irrespective of their pay limit.
2. The question of extending the said facility to the non-teaching staff of aided schools has been under consideration of Govt. for some time. In terms of the agreement between Government and their employees 3-8-1983 , and in consultation with the Commissioner for School Education and after careful consideration Government have decided to provide the said leave facility to the non-teaching staff of Aided schools who suffer from the said diseases, on par with non-teaching staff in Government Schools in this respect.
3. Accordingly Government direct that the leave facility mentioned in para (1) above be extended to the non-teaching staff of private aided schools who suffer from leprosy/tuberculosis/cancer/mental illness /heart deceases on par with the non-teaching staff in Government schools in this ;respect.
4. These orders shall come into force from 1-4-1984
5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance & Planning (Finance.WingF.R.I)Department vide their U.O.No.2124-1702/A2/F.R.-1, dated 10-1-1984.
