ORDER:

Keeping in view the need to fill up all the posts notified for teacher recruitment, and recognizing the shortage of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes and Physically Handicapped castes, Categories with training qualification, the government have taken a decision to make special administrative arrangements to select candidates for imparting is intended to be a special one time measure to clear the large backlog of unfilled vacancies provide teaching assistance in Schools and give appropriate professional orientation to prospective teachers. It would sub-serve both goals of equity and social justice coupled with quality of teaching in schools.

2) Government therefore permits the Commissioner and Director of School Education, Hyderabad to engage the selected (Untrained) candidates of DSC-2002 as Special Vidya volunteers and enroll them in a special training programme commencing from March 2003. The Candidates so selected shall be drafted for practical training by the District Educational officers on merit cum choice basis and shall undertake project and course work as may be prescribed, they shall undergo a foundation course and practical training for a month during march, 2003 the cost of which shall be met under DPEP/SS A-training component, this shall be followed by three months of study during which no stipend shall be paid, the entire training programme shall be spread over two academic years, they shall be paid from July,2003 a monthly stipend of Rs. 1,000 for a period of nine (9) months in each academic year within which period they are expected to complete the training programme and qualify in the prescribed examinations for becoming eligible to be appointed as teachers, the candidates are expected to pay the Course Fee as may be prescribed.

(3) The expenditure towards stipend to the Special vidya volunteers shall be debited to the following Head of Account: -
