The Commissioner & Director of School Education in his letter 4th read above has requested the Government to allow untrained candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Backward Caste and Physically Handicapped candidates for the recruitment test and selecting untrained not be filled up because there are no trained candidates of these categories.

The Commissioner & Director of School Education has further requested that these candidates may be sent for training and after successful completion of the training, they may be appointed in the vacancies against which they were selected. May be appointed in the vacancies against which they were selected.

The Government have examined the above proposals and decided to permit the Commissioner & Director of School Education to call for applications even from untrained candidates for the following posts in respect of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Backward Caste Physically Handicapped candidates in relaxation of rules.

1. Secondary Grade Teachers
2. Language Pandits (Grade-II)
3. Physical Education Teachers.

4. The Government also accord permission to admit the above candidates to D.Ed/Pandit Training/U.G.D.P. Ed. courses by increasing the present intake capacity. The untrained candidates of the above categories shall be selected only to the extent of vacancies which would not be filled-up because there are no qualified trained candidates belonging to the categories.

5. The candidates shall however pursue their studies at their own cost and successfully complete the course. Therefore they will be appointed as teachers after successful completion of training.
