Government in the reference 1st read above have issued orders permitting the Commissioner and Director of School Education, Hyderabad to engage the selected (untrained) candidates belonging to SC/ST/BCs and enroll them in a special training programme commencing from 2003. The candidates so selected shall be drafted for practical training by the DEOs on merit from choice basis and shall undertake project and course work as prescribed. They shall undergo a foundation course and practical training for a month during March 2003 followed by a 3 months of study during which no stipend shall be paid. The entire, training programme shall be spread over in two academic years and they shall be paid a monthly stipend of Rs. 1000/ per month from July 2003 for a period of 9 months in each academic year within which period the selected candidates are expected to complete the training programme and qualify themselves in the prescribed examinations for becoming eligible to be appointed as teachers.

2. Government have enhanced the monthly stipend to be paid to the Special Vidya Volunteers from Rs. 1000/ to 1500/- per month during the second year starting from April 2004 and the training period of the Special Vidya Volunteers will be construed as apprenticeship period and regular scale shall be paid as soon as the candidate successfully completes the training programme in the reference 2nd read above.

3. The Director of School Education in his letter 4th read above, have reported that the Teacher Associations are representing that the regular time scales of pay be given to the Special Vidya Volunteers.

4. Government after careful consideration that earlier these candidates were selected by DSC and appointed as Special Vidya Volunteers as they did not have requisite training qualification and since they have completed training-and thus qualified for appointment as teachers, hereby permitted the Director of School Education to appoint them as teachers on regular scale of pay with prospective effect from the date of issue of these orders by relaxing the need for selection through DSC as they were already selected itx DSC 2002 in the posts.

5. The expenditure towards payment of salaries to these teachers shall be met from the funds available with DPEP under the item of salaries to teachers under Sarva Sikha Abhiyan Programme for the year 2005-2006.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (PC-III) Department vide their U.O.No. 10475/PFS R &E/2005, dt. 19.10.2005.
