A copy of the Government Order vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above is herewith communicated.

2. The Government have permitted the Director of School Education to appoint the Spl. Vidya Volunteers who have passed the training qualification on regular scale of pay with prospective effect by relaxing the need for selection through DSC as they were already selected in DSC-2002 in the posts.

3. All the Dist. Educational Officers in the State are informed that the untrained candidates who were selected in DSC 2002 and engaged as Spl. Vidya Volunteers and have passed the training qualification and become eligible should be appointed as regular teachers in the time scale of pay attached to the post with prospective effect, as per the G.O. (2<sup>nd</sup> cited).

4. The Dist Educational officers should identify the number of clear vacancies and sanctioned posts against which the DSC 2002 un-trained candidates are working (not the posts which are not sanctioned in which some of the special vidya volunteers are said to be working), The number of special Vidya Volunteers (passed training course) and the number of candidates selected for appointment in DSC 2003 are to be counted.

5. If the number of vacancies identified as above are more than the number of candidates to be appointed (Special vidya volunteers passed training qualifications + DSC 2003), such number of vacancies are blocked as per the guidelines issued already.

6. They are informed-that the candidates shall be called for counseling in the order of J selection of DSC 2002.

7. The Dist Educational officers are further informed that the appointment orders to 1 the Special vidya volunteers should be given through counseling as per the guidelines already issued in respect of the candidates of DSC 2003.

8. The Dist Educational officers are hereby instructed to follow the guidelines scrupulously and issue the orders strictly in accordance with the Govt order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above and the guidelines issued in this regard from time to time and any deviations will be viewed seriously.

9. The Dist Educational officers should send the comprehensive report to undersigned in the following proforma within one week after the appointments made.
