In the Government Order No.186, Finance & Planning (F.R.I) Department dated 23rd July, Government accorded sanction for the adoption of certain measures liberalizing the provisions of different leave rules 1 applicable to the Government servants of this State. It has now been decided to further liberalize the leave rules in respect of Government servant who die while in service or who retire on reaching the age of superannuation.

2. Accordingly the following orders are issued :-

- i) The cash equivalent of leave salary, payable to the family of a Government servant who dies in harness, under sub-Para (ii) of Para 2 of the order read above, shall not be reduced by pension and pension equivalent of other retirement benefits. The cash equivalent of leave salary in such cases shall be paid in full, subject to a maximum leave salary for 120 days. The other conditions in sub-Para (ii) of Para 2 of the order read above shall remain intact.
- (ii) Government servants shall be allowed to cash earned leave/privilege leave, at their credit on the date of superannuating subject to a maximum of 120 days by the authority competent to sanction pension, leave salary for this period will not be reduced by pension and pension equivalent of other retirement benefits, which will be admissible on normal date of superannuating.
- (iii) The period of leave as contemplated by sub-Para (ii) of Para 2 of this order shall not constitute extension in service.

3. These orders shall take effect from 1st June, 1975.

4. Necessary amendments to various sets of leave rules will be issued separately.
